Entry Requirements and Instructions

- All entries will be accepted, subject to restrictions below or exhibition capacity being reached. Entry deadline is March 15.
- Open to living artists 18 years of age or older.
- Concept, design, and execution of artwork must be solely that of the individual artist entering it. Original work only. No prints allowed.
- Colored pencil must constitute 60% or more of the work.
- Artwork must not have been exhibited previously at an annual CPSA DC 201 judged show. No restriction on year completed.
- You may enter one to three works. The third one is provisional and hung only if there is space. Maximum framed size: 32" x 40".

- Frame must be ready to hang with D-rings and wire ONLY.
- Frames should be simple in design, with white, off-white, beige, gray or black mats only. Glazing, if any, may be acrylic or glass.
- All artwork must remain in place throughout the show.
- Keizer Art Association will retain a 30% commission on all sales.
- Art must be delivered and picked up according to the schedule. If you are unable to deliver or pick up your work, contact another chapter member near you to ask if they can take yours. There are no designated drivers this year.
- Show managers reserve the right to eliminate an entry if they determine the art does not meet requirements.
- Entry constitutes agreement with all terms of this prospectus.
